**It is right to give our thanks and praise.**

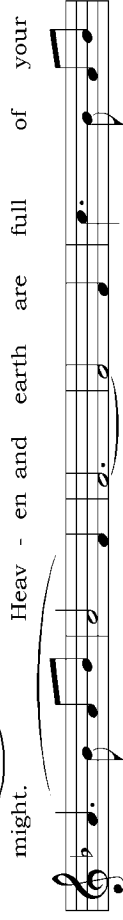
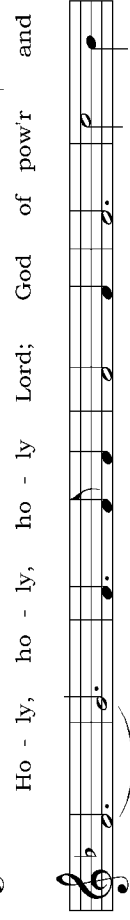
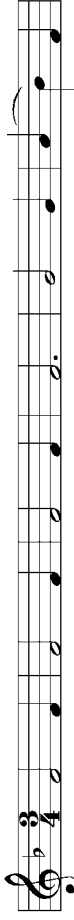
It is right, and a good and joyful thing,

neither shall they learn war anymore.

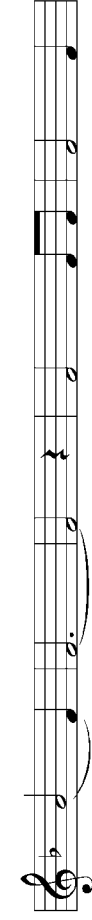
And so,

we praise your name and join their unending hymn:



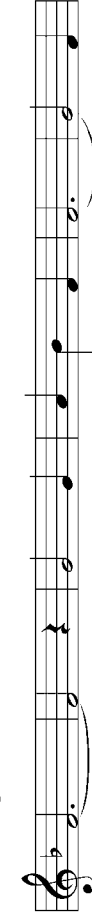

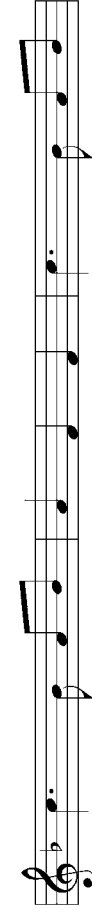
