**It is right to give our thanks and praise.**

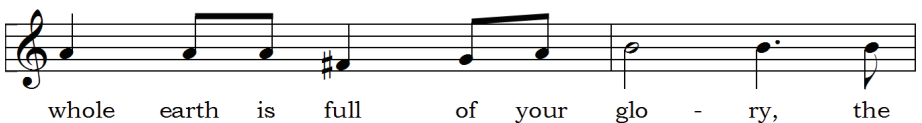
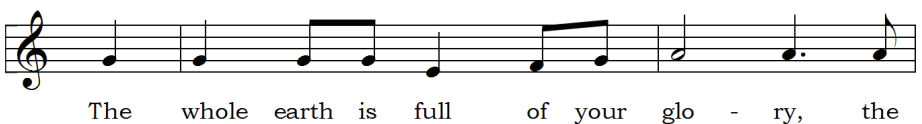
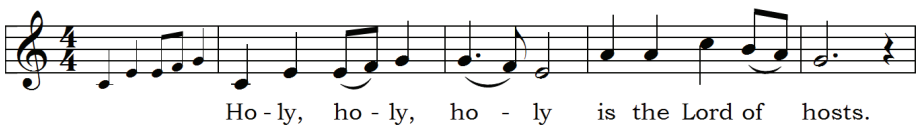
It is right, and a good and joyful thing,
