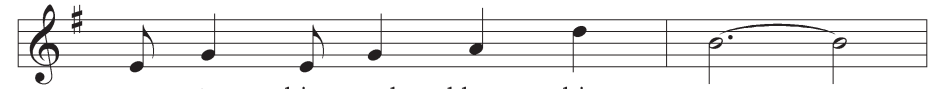

It is right to give our thanks and praise.

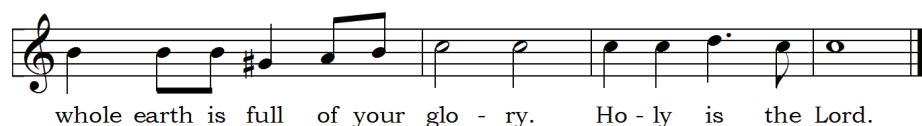
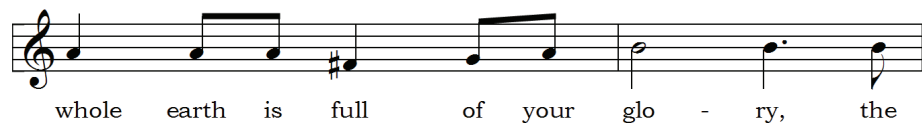
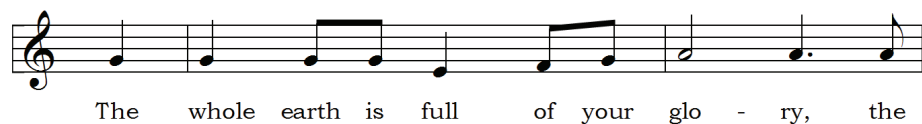
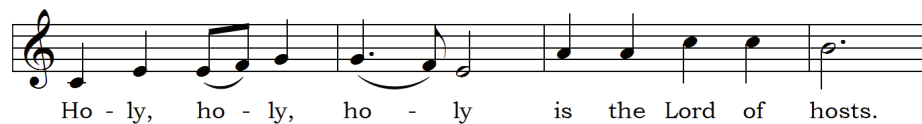
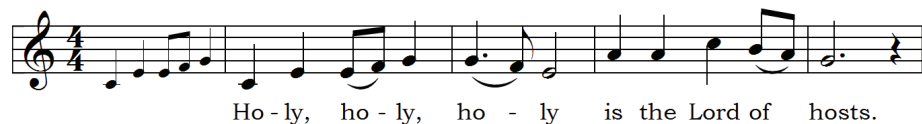
It is right, and a good and joyful thing,

your love remained steadfast.

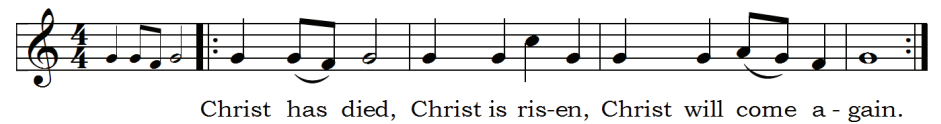
You delivered us from captivity,

we praise your name and join their unending hymn:



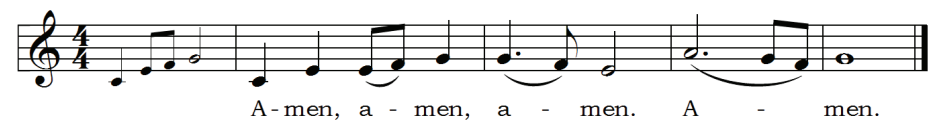
Please be seated. The pastor continues leading the prayer, recalling the acts of Christ.
